The Best Tips and Tricks: Android Kitkat



1 - Switch your launcher

Android is the most versatile mobile OS around and you have the option to customise the interface. If you don't like your manufacturer UI, it's possible to replace the interface with a third-party alternative.

2 - Try Google Now voice commands

It's now possible to launch Google Now by saying "OK Google" towards your handset. You can have a rudimentary conversation with the phone to clarify what you're searching for.

3 - Delve into Developer Mode

Open the Settings menu, head into About Phone, and scroll to the bottom – then tap Build Number seven times in quick succession. Once done, you find a Developer Mode option in the Settings menu. This has several options related to performance and diagnostics.

4-Record Video

Taking screenshots in Android is easy. In KitKat it's possible to record video direct from your phone. It's useful for creating tutorials. First install the Android Debug Bridge, then head to the Developer Mode in the Setting and enable it. Connect your handset to a PC and you're ready.

5 - Boost your phone's performance

Save power by using Wi-Fi and mobile networks to determine your location instead of GPS. It'll improve your battery life. To change this option go to Settings > Location > Mode. It's a better Battery Saving option.

6 - Disable App Notifications

App notifications also drain your phone's battery. Turn them off: 1) On any of your unwanted notifications in your notification bar, long press on the notification for a message box to appear. 2) Tap on App Info > Untick Show Notifications > OK.

7 - Disable Mobile Data

Whenever you don't need to stay connected, disabling the Mobile Data can help keep your smartphone battery from draining too quickly: 1) Going to Settings > Data Usage. 2) Disable Mobile data by toggling the setting from ON to OFF.

8 - Set Mobile Data Limit

Want to keep track of how far your usage is from your monthly mobile data limit: 1) Head over to Settings > Data Usage. 2) Set your data limit by dragging the orange line to reflect your monthly quota. 3) Set your data usage cycle based on when your "month" starts and ends.

9-Add Multiple Google Accounts

To add multiple Google accounts: 1) Go to Settings > Add account. 2) Select Google and setup your New or Existing Google account. 3) Once added, choose what you want to sync with the account.

10 - Disable automatic App Updates

You can, disable your automatic app updates. Here are the steps: 1) Open Play Store and head over to Settings. 2) Tap on Auto-update apps. 3) Choose Do not auto-update apps.

11 - How To Check For android System updates

You may want to look for new updates to your system. To check for updates: 1) Go to Settings > About phone/tablet. 2) Tap on System updates. 3) Tap Check now to look for system updates.

12 - Changing Default Apps

If you have already set some default apps for particular tasks but wish to change this: 1) Go to Settings > Apps. 2) Swipe right and look for the All tab. 3) Select the app you want to remove as default. 4) Tap on Clear defaults.

13 - Organize Home screen Shortcuts with Folders

Long press on any of the shortcuts and drag it onto another shortcut. A circle should now appear around the apps, indicating that a folder has been created. You can drag and drop additional apps into the folder.

14 - Disable Animations

Make your Android device run a bit smoother by disabling its animations. Under Developer options, look for Window animation scale, Transition animation scale, and Animator duration scale. Then, turn them off.

15 - How to Turn Off Auto-Correction

Turn off auto-correction. 1) Go to Settings > Language & input. 2) Tap on the settings icon next to the keyboard that you are using. 3)Look for Auto-correction and tap on it. 4) Select Off to turn auto-correction off.
