Tips and Tricks for Shopping Online

1. Visit other similar sites first

Don't go to different stores physically while you can just have a price comparison of what you are looking for in a few clicks. Just open a new tab and check if you can find a lower price on a competitor's website. Sites like Froogle and Bizrate also do this for you. This could save you hundreds of rupees, depending on what you're shopping for.

2. Sign up for rewards and insider programs

The benefits vary from brand to brand and site to site, but can range from discounts to advance previews and special sales — especially useful on flash sale sites like Gilt.

3. Clear your browsing data

When you search for something to buy or to book an air ticket and you see the price jumps after few days when you look for that thing again. It could just be because the price went up, or it's most likely because you were cookied and served a higher price. By clearing your browser data, you can avoid this unfair price jump.

4. Leave your cart full

You can also play the system by intentionally leaving your cart full. The retailer knows you're interested in buying, so odds are, in a few days (or less!), they'll email you with a deal on the item(s) you wanted to purchase.

Use an "incognito" window

You can also purchase via an "incognito" window. Browsers have an option that blocks websites from cookie-ing your movements, meaning they won't raise the price because you've looked at it before.

6. Sign up for newsletters and email lists

Retailers often offer exclusive deals to their email subscribers. Before you check out, make sure you sign up for their email list. You'll probably get an introductory offer.

7. Follow stores on social media

Many online retailers announce exclusive deals on their social media accounts first. Follow your favorite stores on Twitter and Facebook for grabbing exclusive deals.

8. Use the right credit card when checking out

Knowing your credit card's rewards program can save you big bucks. If you have tons of points, some cards allow you to use them on discounted gift cards at certain retailers. Some cards also award additional points for shopping at partner retailers.

9. Visit rebate sites

By going to sites like Ebates and FatWallet, you can get cash back through their portal. In other words, not only do you get points on your credit card, you can actually make money when you shop.

10. Shop on the right day

Choose the right day for shopping like on festivals, almost all the retailer websites launch festival offers. Otherwise in weekdays, Sunday is the best day to buy airfare, while other online retailers tend to release offers on Wednesday and Thursday for their products.

11. Don't pay for shipping

Amazon Prime offers free two-day shipping all the time, if you don't have it, sign up for a free month-long trial. Other online stores have offers where if you spend more than X rupees amount, you get free shipping. You can also sign up for sites like FreeShipping.com.

12. Apply right coupon codes

Some web sites let you apply coupon codes, but don't just hit and try. Look for coupon sites amr. Suyash Bhardwaj choose the right code for your deal to get amazing cash back or discounts.
